Background:

In 2001, Toronto City Council adopted the Toronto Bike Plan. This Plan calls for the creation of a comprehensive Bikeway Network throughout the city, and includes the introduction of bicycle lanes on Bloor Street between Kipling Ave. and Mill Rd., and The West Mall between the Bloor Street and The Queensway.

Public Works and Infrastructure Committee will consider these projects for recommendation to Council at an upcoming meeting.
